POLICY POSITIONS



Vocal advocate for mass deportations and a border wall

- Put forth articles of impeachment against President Biden for his responsibility for the migrant crisis in June 2023; authored the Build the Wall and Deport Them All Act, which aimed to finish building a wall along the US-Mexico border, ban federal funding of sanctuary cities, restore the Trump-era "Remain in Mexico" policy, and mass deport undocumented persons



Backs efforts to expand domestic oil production

- Proposed the American Energy Act in 2023, aiming to extend terms for drilling permits and restrict the length of environmental reviews for drilling projects; wrote the Colorado Energy Prosperity Act in an attempt to leverage Colorado's land for oil and gas production

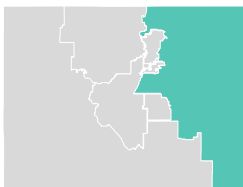
